45-1 is a premium grade contact adhesive designed to bond to Cableguard™ wrap as a walk surface base coat.

Preparation of Substrates

Heated Cableguard should be cleaned of all dust, oils or other contaminants using xylene. Dry all surfaces thoroughly before applying adhesive.

Method of Application

Stir thoroughly until product is a consistent color before using. Apply one heavy coat of adhesive with a brush or roller. Immediately after application, sprinkle walk surface grit over the contact adhesive.

Cleaner and Thinner

Toluene.
